I previously notified you that I am a victim of identity theft/fraud, and requested that you do the following:

RE: Disputed Account – 271534xxxx and etc.

- Close any unauthorized account
- Remove any charges on the unauthorized account, and
- Take steps to remove information about these accounts from my credit lines.

I still have not received written confirmation of these actions. As I stated before. My personal information and accounts were used fraudulently. Please send me written confirmation that I am not responsible for charges on these accounts and take appropriate steps to remove information about these accounts from my credit files.

I have enclosed a copy of my FTC Identity Theft Report. The information reported on my credit report is the result of identity theft/fraud, and inaccurate, I request that you take over the fraudulent accounts from the CRA, as directed by section 623(a)(1)(B) of the Fair Credit Reporting Act, 15 U.S.C. Section 1681s-2 (a)(1)(B). I ask that you take these steps as soon as possible.

I also enclosed a copy of the FTC's Notice to Furnishers, which explains your responsibilities. Please stop this fraudulent act and get these accounts/disputed items deleted as soon as possible.

Please send me a letter explaining your actions.

I am a victim of your crimes, and I am writing to dispute all fraudulent charges on my accounts.
