Do I have to relocate if I were to accept a position with Gabsie?

No, this is a remote, work from home incumbent and you are not expected to relocate if you accept an offer with Gabsie.

Do you have any part-time position available that I can apply to?

Unfortunately, Gabsie only hires full-time employees. We pride in offering a wide range of benefits to all our employees and hiring part-time won't allow us to extend these benefits to our entire workforce. We do have students and housewives among our staff, and they find this job easy to maintain alongside with their school or childcare commitments.

Are there any out of pocket expenses for me to worry about?

There may be minimal out of pocket expenses in the form of paper, printing supplies, packaging materials, in-town driving etc. All these expenses are reimbursable. If you have questions about specific expenses and whether that's reimbursed by Gabsie, please reach out to your supervisor.

Is this position benefits eligible?

Yes, all full-time, permanent positions are benefit eligible at Gabsie. However, probationary employees are not benefitted as they are classified as individual contractors for their initial 30 days of employment.

Permanent employees enjoy 14 paid sick and 28 paid vacation time every calendar year of employment. Gabsie also offers medical, dental, and vision benefits. Premium and coverage will vary from state to state. Permanent employees become eligible for health benefits starting the 2nd month of their employment. Gabsie also offers a retirement plan with company matching.

How many packages do I have to process every week?

Number of assignments will vary, and you'll likely see more packages during holiday or other busy shopping seasons. On average, probationary employees receive anywhere between 5 to 30 assignments each week while permanent staff process around 50.

Is there an opportunity to earn commissions on top of the regular pay?

No commission is offered, and all our staff are salaried. However, certain processing may qualify you for bonus pay. See Employment Agreement for bonus pay criteria.
