

What is the job title?

Name of the position: Independent Quality Inspector

Where is it located?

The job is home-based. You will be working from home.

Is there training?

The training lasts one month and takes place at home. During this period of time, you will be learning the process and working at the same time. You will be paid at the end of the training. Most of the communication will be done via email and less often over the phone. I will be answering your questions and providing you with the instructions, guidance, and training required to advance in this position.

What are the main duties?

The main duty will be to check the intactness of returned goods for further realization. The basic job functions are to receive packages at your residence where you open them, inspect the goods for damage, perform the assessment, take pictures, write concise reports, and email them to me. Electronic devices do not require functionality checks, only factory packaging and overall condition. The next step will be to ship the inspected goods. To do that, you will be given a pre-paid shipping label in the form of a digital pdf document. The postage is always paid by the company.

You are to print a label, adhere it to a package, and ship it. You can use transparent duct tape or peel-and-stick paper to affix a label to a package.

How will I be paid?

As for the payment, a paycheck is mailed one month after the commencement date. The first completed task will commence your 30 day pay period/probation period. \$2,300 plus \$30 for each completed case. Every case ends with you sending me the incoming and outgoing tracking numbers. The inspector general paid via 1099 with no taxes taken out. To be paid on time, two main conditions must be met:

First: All packages that you will be receiving during the training must be inspected and shipped following my instructions.

Second: When you receive a label for a package, the package must be shipped within 24 hours.

Every day of delay postpones payday.

401k, dental, and health insurance will become available upon completion of the first month. That is when I will ask you to fill out additional forms.

Why will the names on the packages be different?

The goods are addressed either to the previous buyer's name and agent's address or have an invoice with the agent's name on it. Why? It all depends on the case when a return of goods takes place. If it is an interception, then the package has the buyer's name and the agent's address. If the original purchase was rejected or never picked up from a store, we would redeem it. Therefore, the package will have an invoice with the agent's name and address. The agent's information is on the invoice to ensure that the package reaches the agent, and, of course, the goods are paid for by the company.

Thus, the goods are collected in our warehouses for further export or distribution to auctions and retail within the country. We cooperate with a variety of postal services, so we get a discount on shipping labels. All of it allows us to develop a network of home-based agents and pay high wages.

How does the company profit by doing this?

We work in all areas of the insurance industry; support fraud investigators; insure goods; and protect online stores from fraudsters. We more than insure; we intercept illegally purchased goods that were bought using stolen credit cards. We monitor and investigate every purchase the moment it is made. When our experts notice something shady, we intercept a package and pay the insurance to the stores we work with. We also

sign a continuous service agreement with online stores and make a profit irrespective of the number of insurance cases. Thanks to buying intercepted goods for the price of second-hand goods (albeit they're brand new), we managed to set up channels of distribution overseas.

Is there a cost to starting?

There is no cost to start.

What equipment would I need?

You will need basic office supplies like scissors, duct tape, paper, and ink for your printer. To ship inspected goods to their destination, you will be given a pre-paid shipping label in the form of a digital document. You are to print the label and adhere it to the package to ship it. Transparent duct tape or peel-n-stick paper can be used to affix a label to a package.

If I needed to purchase something, would the company reimburse my expenses?

We reimburse all reasonable expenses related to this job (including the mentioned stationery). Other examples:

*gas or taxi (if you have to drive the packages to the post office)

scissors, duct tape, black marker* boxes for packages – only if you need to buy them to re-pack goods, or if an item cannot be shipped in its original box* paper and ink for a printer* you won't need a scale, so you don't need to buy it.

To get reimbursed, send me pictures of the receipts with your expenses so our financial department will round up the sum and add it to your monthly payment.

How many packages would I receive? Do I need storage?

Qty of the packages:

5 to 15 weekly, during the training, and 10 to 30 weekly, after the training.

The packages aren't heavy and require little space.

If I change my mind, how do I terminate employment?

The contract stipulates that upon the termination of employment, an employee must ship all packages in their possession.

2. There are no pending incoming packages.

3. The employee must give five days' notice to his supervisor.

If the above conditions are met, the employment can be terminated without penalty.

In the event of non-observance of provisions of the agreement and the employee's unilateral termination of employment, a court would impose a fine on the employee equal to the cost of items in the employee's possession plus the cost of the goods which are to be delivered to the employee's address.

What would be my schedule?

The schedule is flexible. Delivery hours (when you can expect the packages) depend only on your local delivery services. This is why someone must always be at home to sign for and accept the packages. You will be notified about all incoming packages, but it doesn't change the fact that a courier may reschedule a delivery. You will work dayshours Monday to Friday, 8 am to 5 pm. You are required to be home and available during these time frames. As I said, I will be notifying you about incoming packages, so you should be able to track them and plan your schedule to be at home for the delivery.
