

Hi Timothy,

Sorry I took a moment to respond to your email, I usually don't check my email when I'm off at work so I didn't get to see your message until when I got to the office now.

And to start with; I'm Naomi Scott (I'll be 37 next April) and my husband is David Hulet but we call him Dave (he'll be 40 in February). We're both natives of South Africa but I moved to the United State in 2016 for my Post Graduate degree in Business Administration so I met my husband here in school, Dave is a cloud engineer so he basically works as a consultant or contract staff for various companies while I work with a non profit organization for adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities as the finance director. We'll consider ourselves an easy going couple. I'm partly deaf but I hear absolutely pretty well with the assistance of my cochlear implant.

However, we need a caring and trustworthy pet caregiver for our 2 lovely dogs (Busta & Jeff), this position may be permanent or temporary depending on your availability and schedule. My husband's just got a contract with an employer that has a project on integration of their on premises database to the S3 bucket and my husband will be the team leader in charge of their cloud storage architecture so we need to relocate from our present place to your area in few weeks' and we'll be needing a someone to walk our fur children because I am 6 months pregnant and I won't be able to do much with the dogs until I give birth, we're expecting to have a girl and this is our first human child so we want everything to go perfectly well.

Jeff is a 4 year old (German shepherd) Dave got him in London and we consider him as our first son, Busta is a 2 and half year old (Siberian Husky) and he plays our second child. They are both cuddly, very friendly with other dogs and not aggressive around strangers so you won't have any problem when you meet and walk them, although Busta can be naughty sometimes but it's nothing to worry about.. They're quite spoiled and very lovely, Jeff has a run that he is hooked to when our neighbor's chickens are out but when they're roosting he goes a free range of a long miles, LOL... They receive Bark-Boxes every month end and they're allowed on our furniture despite Jeff's shedding. They've really been one of our lives' greatest blessings and I'm very glad that Dave also loves them as much as I do.

They mean everything to us and we'll be really happy if we can have someone that will care and love them just as much as we do. We'll be needing you to brush their coats and take them for walks at least once every week, they are leash trained so there won't be any hard time whenever you walk them, you can walk them together or you can take turns to walk them separately. I can still sometimes manage with their feeding and you can also feed them anytime you're around.

However, the major part is the dogs are arriving a day before us because they'll be transported by a shipping company while we'll be joining them with our luggages the next day so they'll be delivered to our new home in the evening before we arrive the next morning. So my husband is willing to pay you up front just to be sure we've

secured you for the position before the dogs arrive and also for you to help us get the dogs food with brush and other things needed for them before their arrival. They'll be delivered in their crates so you'll only just need to stop by to let them out for a few minutes and feed them just for the evening.

So when we arrive and settle in, we'll be needing you for any 2 days of your choice weekly for 2 hours each day, totaling 4 hours every week, although we'd prefer to have a set schedule but we can also be flexible if your weekly routine is not stable, we'll just need you to give us heads up if there will be any change of schedule. You'll be coming to take care of the dogs in our house, I'll be at home everytime you come since I'm pregnant and won't be working when we arrive till I give birth.. Our budget is \$35 per hour for both dogs. Kindly let us know the 2 days and the time that will be convenient for you to walk the dogs.

Moreso we'll need your zip code for an insight of how close you'll be to our new home so to enable us to calculate your transportation cost if needed.

SCHEDULE & PAYMENT: 2 DAYS FOR THE TOTAL OF 4 HOURS EVERY WEEK (2 hours daily for any 2 days weekly, making 4 hours weekly at \$35 per hour for both dogs & \$140 per week)
