Great to hear back from you. You sound adorable, we'd really love to have you look after our fur children and we hope you'd give them a tender care. We're a pleasant couple and you have nothing to worry about cuz you'll have no difficult moment working with us. Honestly, we'd have loved to meet you before you start but our tentative arrival date is on December 18th but the dogs will get there on December 17th so meeting you before the dogs' arrival won't be possible since they'll get there a day before us. They'll arrive in the afternoon if everything goes as planned, we'll make all necessary arrangements with the shipping company to deliver them to our place, they'll be in their crates for the night till we'll join them the next morning so you don't have to worry about boarding them at your place or staying overnight with them:) we'll only need you to just stop by and feed them after they deliver them in the evening before we join them in the morning if that's convenient for you but if you won't be available on their arrival date we can make an alternative arrangement for them with the shipping company for the evening..

And for your upfront security payment we'll make out a certified check to you to cover your first week payment so to be sure we've secured your service for the position before our arrival and also for you to help us procure the needed items. And the subsequent payments will be made by cash or what ever payment method you prefer at the end of every week. So for the first payment, you'll receive a check from Dave's employer which you'll deduct your advance payment for the first week and the remaining money from the check will be used to buy the Dog foods, brush with some other things needed for them when they arrive and you'll also help us get a few kitchenware for the house. You'll have to do the kitchenware shopping before we get there as we'd like to have everything in place before we arrive so you won't have to start running around after the dogs arrive.
